YES, we can

- Provide you with the telephone number of the Law Society of Tasmania's referral service.
- Explain and answer questions about how the Court works.
- Give you general information about court rules, procedures and practices.
- Provide court schedules and information on how to get a case listed.
- Give you information from your court file.
- Give you samples of court forms that are available.
- Usually answer questions about court deadlines and how to work them out.

NO, we cannot

- Tell you whether or not you should bring your case to court.
- Tell you what words to use in your court papers. However, we will check your papers for compliance e.g. signatures, correct court location, correct case number.
- Tell you what to say in court.
- Give you an opinion about what will happen if you bring your case to court.
- Talk to the Magistrate for you.
- Let you talk to the Magistrate outside of court.
- Change an order made or signed by a Magistrate.
